

Individual Memberships

REGULAR U\$175

- STUDENT U\$50 Enrollment status must be ³/₄ Full time Not employed full time outside of the University (proof must be provided)
- SENIOR U\$100 Five years of consecutive individual membership At least 64 years of age

CAB Memberships

\$0.00 (CAB Organization pays yearly dues, instead of employee)

Does not meet individual membership requirement for Certification

Must use CAB Organization email




- 4. Download and fill in Form 1. You can find instructions and good examples here.
- 5. Upload Form 1 and confirm your personal information.
- 6. Follow prompts to make the payment for the \$350 CSEP Application fee
- 7. Send out notification emails to your references along with form 4A & 4B asking them to send their completed form to Sep-reference@incose.net
- 8. Once all references and form has been received, application will go into a queue to be assigned to a review team
- 9. INCOSE Central will notify results within 45-60 days.
 If review was denied, ASEP will be offered. If review was successful, CSEP will be awarded
